



Reading Gumball Choices

The number of gumball points you earn each week is completely up to you. The minimum assignment is worth three points.

- 1 gumball for reading 80 to 100 pages for the week
- 1 gumball for writing summary of what you read that is at least 10 sentences long
- 1 gumball for a colored illustration or representation of what you read

You can earn extra gumballs with more effort. Below are some possibilities.

- 1 gumball for every additional 80 to 100 pages read for the week
- 1 point for making a bulleted list of details to be included in your summary (the list must be turned in with your assignment to receive the extra points)
- 1 gumball for typing your summary
- 1 gumball for having a parent edit your first draft and making corrections (the first draft must be turned in with your assignment to receive the extra points)
- 1 – 2 gumballs for including an additional detailed paragraph about a personal connection to what you read

You might also choose to do an extra project along with your summary. Gumball points will be awarded based on effort and creativity. You will also get extra gumball point for presenting your extra efforts to the class the following week. Below are some possible projects. Let your creativity shine and have fun!!!

- Create a model of a character from your book.
- Write a book review if you finished the book.
- Write a newspaper article about an important event.
- Write and present a news report about an important event.
- Make a diorama of a scene.
- Design a PowerPoint presentation about a problem, relationship, or character sketch.
- Write and present a puppet show to act out a scene between two characters.
- Create a diary the main character may have written.
- Make a scrapbook of a character's adventure.
